Originating from North American Indian tribes, adopted by the scouting movement, and engraved on the headstone of Lord Baden-Powell, the symbol is known as “Gone Home”, and we feel is very appropriate to the garden.

Twin brothers Luke & Matt were born in Lewisham hospital and their early years were spent in an around the London Boroughs of Lewisham and Southwark.

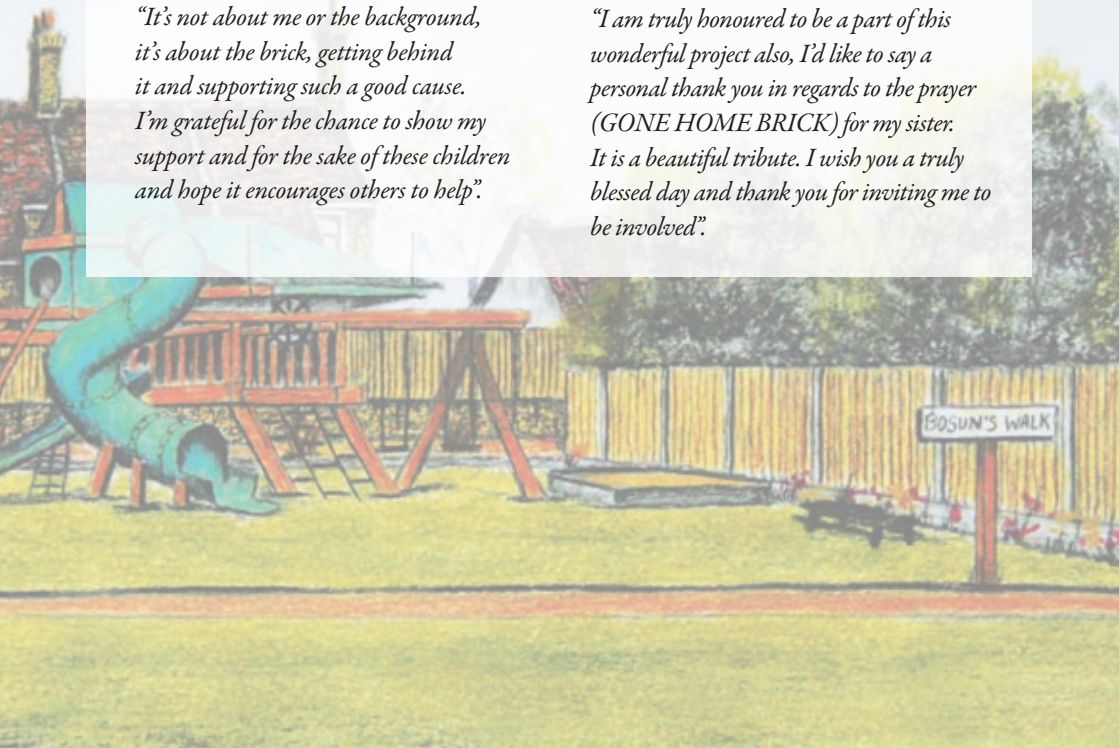

The brick pavers are 210mm x 105mm, engineering strength. 'Big' brick pavers are 210mm x 210mm The lettering is professionally engraved and then coloured with a long-lasting black or gold infill.

Choose the lettering colour you want (if applicable) Black (standard) Gold (option at additional cost)

Captain's Stones

Stone details

Cut from the finest quality granite, with polished face, carefully engraved and coloured. The Stone measures 400mm x 400mm

Gone Home Paver

Memorial Paver Details

Manufactured to the same high standard as our Bosun's Pavers, these pavers measure 210mm x 105mm and will be placed in our Memorial Garden

Lettering in Black beneath the "Gone Home" symbol
